



Dear parents,

We are Miss Benjamin and Miss Ross, the Year 3 teachers. Miss Benjamin is the teacher for Sea Turtle class and Miss Ross is the teacher for Seahorse class. This letter will contain important information regarding Year 3.

**PE-** PE will be on Tuesday afternoons so children will need to come to school in their PE kit. Our P.E. kit consists of a plain white t-shirt and bottle green shorts and trainers. Sometimes KS2 pupils require tracksuit bottoms for colder weather. These must be black/navy/grey. Any earrings must be removed or taped up in advance and long hair tied back. Children will also need to make sure they bring water bottles for PE lessons.

**Snacks-** In Year 3 children are required to bring their own snack to consume during break time. This snack must not contain any nuts. The snack needs to be a piece of fruit or vegetable.

**Homework-** Homework will be handed out and back in on Fridays, this means children have a week to complete the homework. The homework will consist of spelling, reading and times table homework. Reading should be recorded in reading journals, this is something that will be checked regularly by the class teachers with an aim of reading to an adult at home at least 3x a week.

**Uniform-** Children must wear correct uniform for school. In KS2 there is an expectation that children wear a blazer and tie. Other appropriate uniform includes- Smart grey shorts, Dress (Candy stripes of green and white, short sleeved), White shirt with a school tie or white blouse with revere collar, Cardigan or V neck pullover with school badge (available from Coes), Grey skirts only. No pinafore dresses, Smart grey short or long trousers, Pullover Green, V neck with school badge and grey or white Socks. Please remember to clearly name all items including water bottles and lunchboxes so they can be returned to your child if lost.
