

# Autumn Term

Our focused books for this term are

Ug – Boy Genius of the Stone Age

The Pebble in My Pocket: A History of Our Earth

**Computing:** Learning how computers connect together to form networks and to create animations using computer software. Child will also learn about using and navigating the internet and technology in a safe and responsible manner.

**English:** This term your child will be continuing to write for a range of different genres; letter writing, diary entries, stories and recounts. Ensuring that their writing is coherent, through the use of conjunctions, punctuation and interesting vocabulary. This will be practised in English work with incorporated SPAG sessions. Focusing on using and applying the Year 3 common exception words, along with using their phonological awareness to spell unfamiliar words and suffixes. Children will also practise their handwriting and will work towards forming all joins correctly.

**History:** Exploring life in Stone Age Britain using a variety of sources to find out about the changes that occurred during this time.

**Geography:** Using Atlases and Maps to locate cities, regions, rivers, countries and seas in the UK.

**French:** Greetings and in introduction to French (colours, numbers)

**PE:** Working on our Team work, accuracy and evasion skills in dodgeball and football

**Science:** This term your child will learn about the different categories of rocks and the process of fossilization.

**RE:** During the term your child will learn about how Christians show that 'reconciliation' with God and other people is important as well as looking at 'Submission' in Islam

**Maths:** Throughout the year your child will be taught mathematics through the mastery approach. This will involve learning through use of practical equipment, discussion, drawing and formal written methods. The areas we will cover this term are place value, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

**Music:** Writing Music Down - Learning about notation; composing simple rhythmic patterns to a steady pulse.

**DT:** Children will work to a brief to design, make and evaluate a themed maze. They will practice cutting, joining and constructing using different materials.

**Art:** Exploring and creating different techniques used in the Stone Age including hand print art, clay pot making and stone painting.

**PSHE:** Being me in my world. Celebrating difference. The children will begin to understand how zones of regulation works and to develop their emotional literacy.
