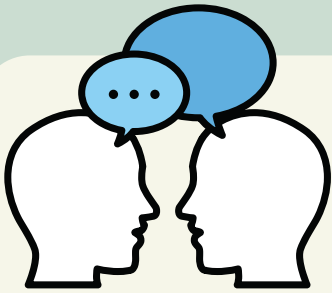


Girls Year 6 Football

Our PTA, who raise an enormous amount of money for our children, urgently require a secretary.

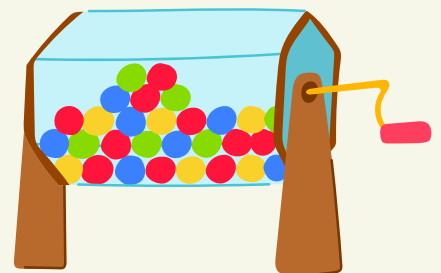
This role would involve some administrative tasks and managing emails and communication with the school. If you have a couple of hours a week and you have skills in this area we would love to hear from you.

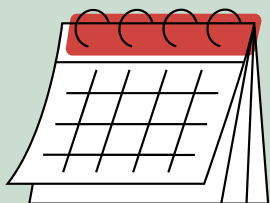
